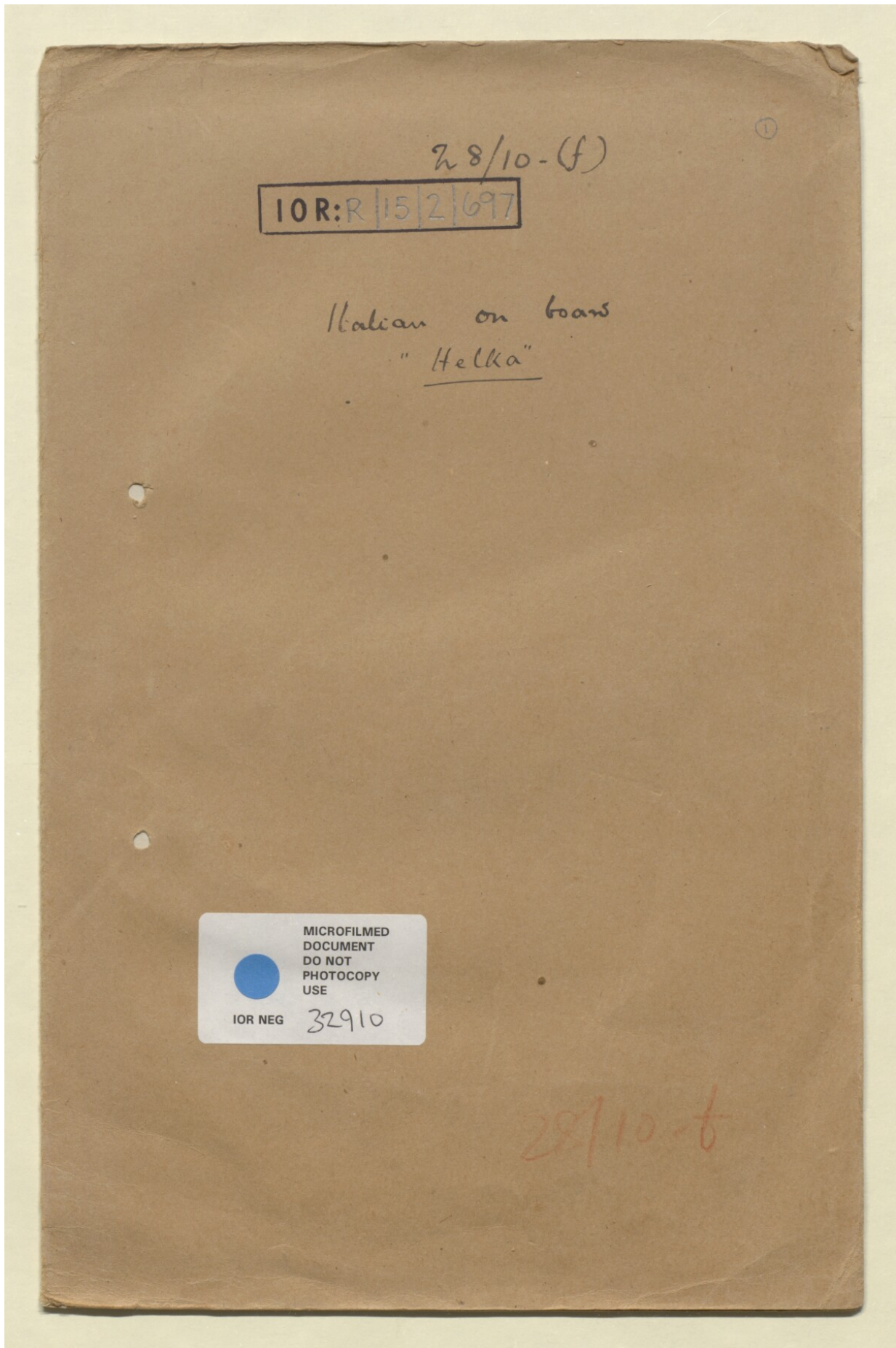

#### About this record

The file comprises correspondence relating to the presence on board the tanker *Helka*, sailing from Aden to Bahrain, of an Italian, whom British officials instruct should not be allowed to land at Bahrain. The principal correspondents are: the Political Agent at Bahrain (Hugh Weightman), the Chief Secretary at Aden; and the Chief Local Representative of the Bahrain Petroleum Company BAPCO (R A Kennedy).







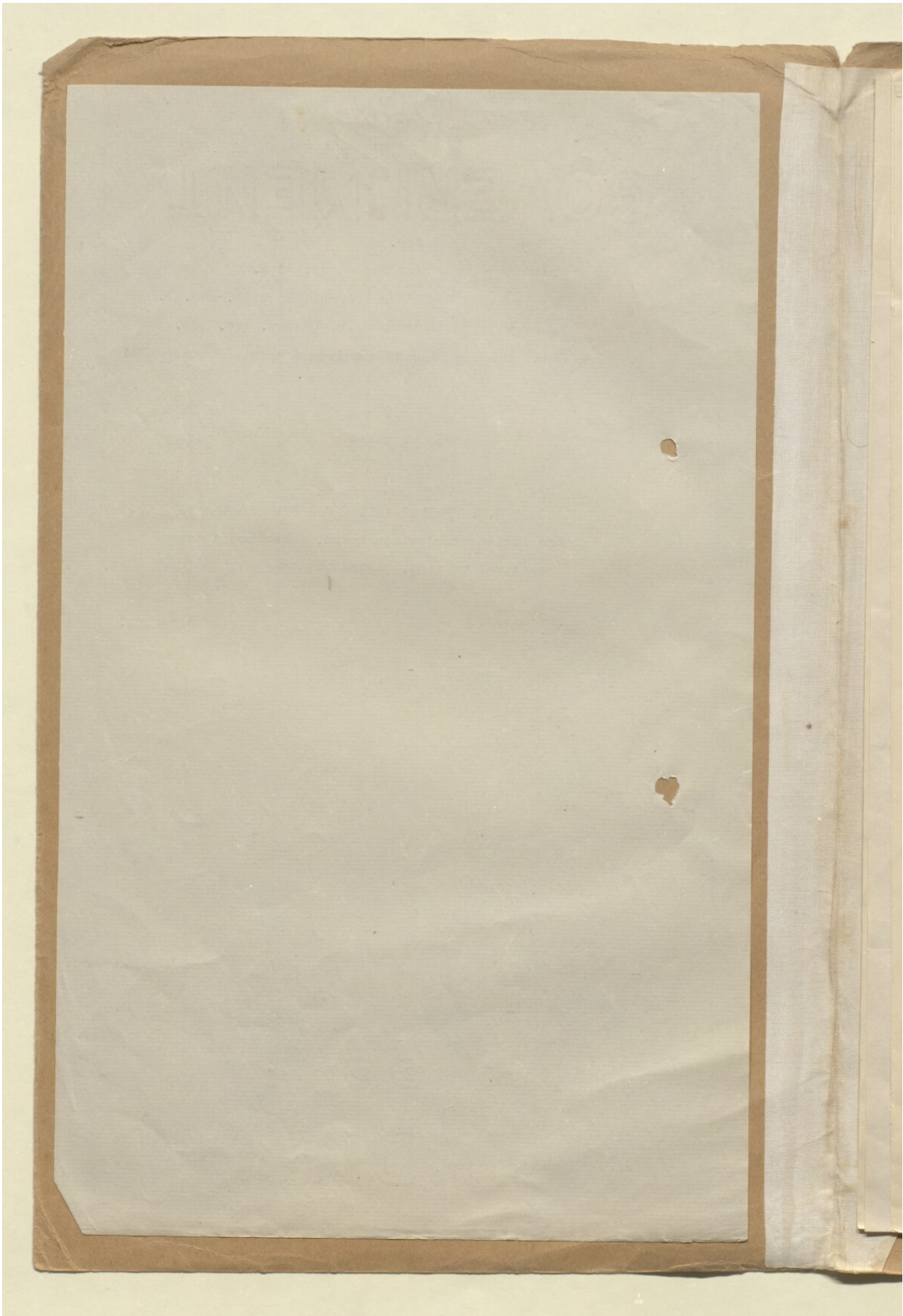

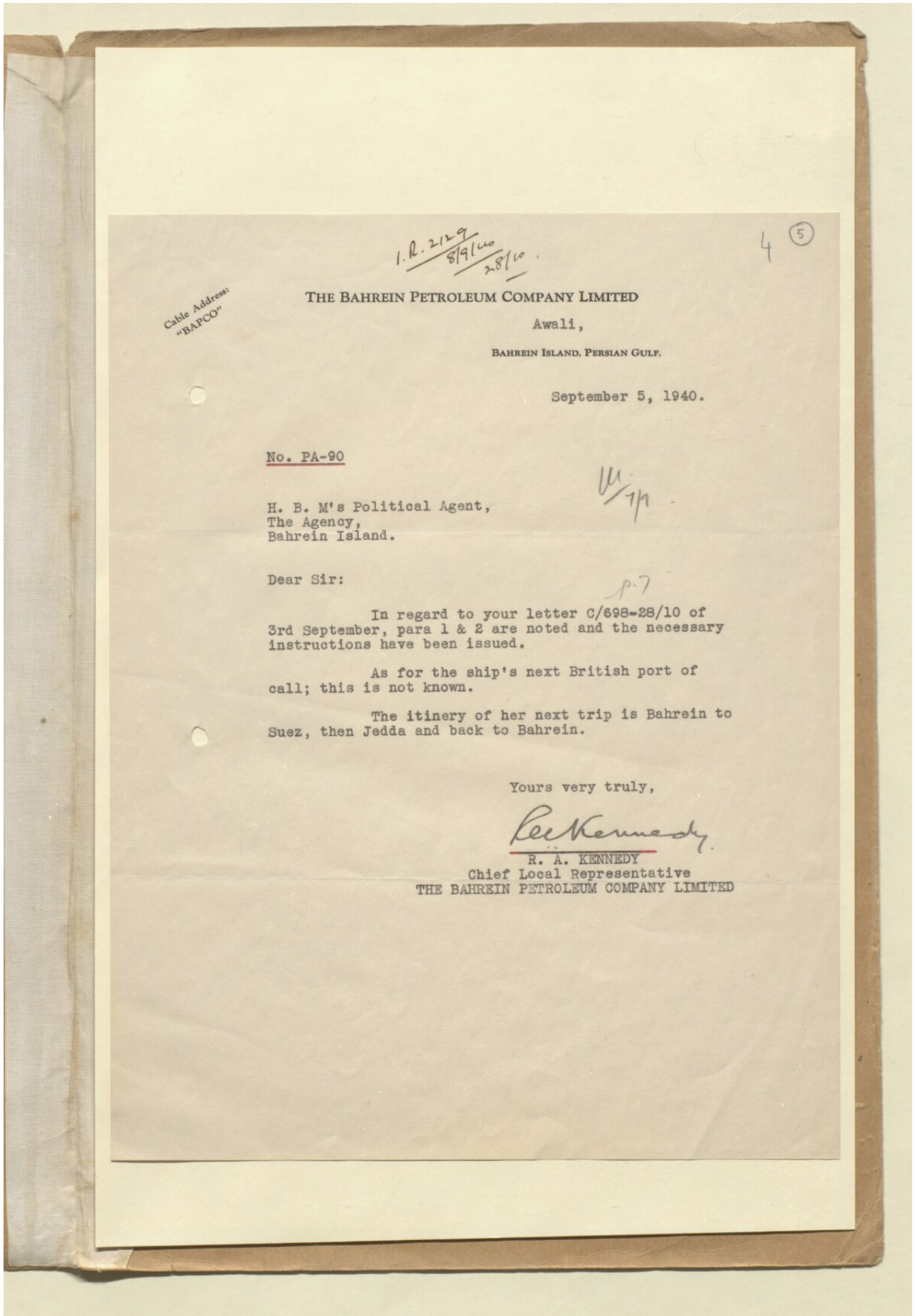
3. Will you please inform me of her next British port of call ?

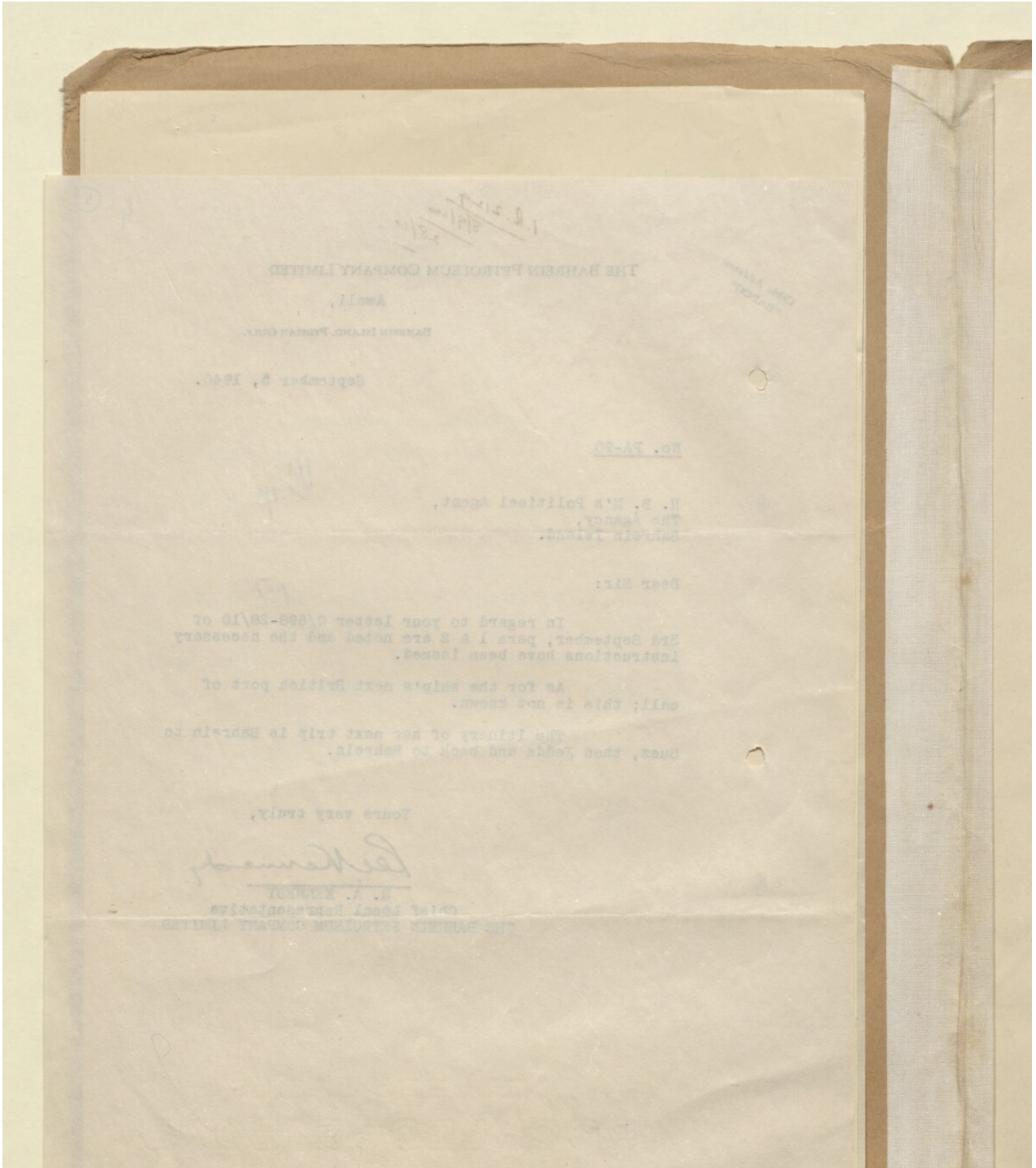
