#### About this record

This file consists of file notes and a letter, dated 12 April 1916, from the Under Secretary of State for India to the Under Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs which accompanied four parcels of original files of the German consulate at Bushire relating to the Abu Musa Oxide concession. The notes on the front of the file consist of a query (dated, 15 April 1916) as to whether it is necessary to read through the papers and the reply (dated, 17 April 1916) that it could wait until the end of the war, when the question could be resolved.
