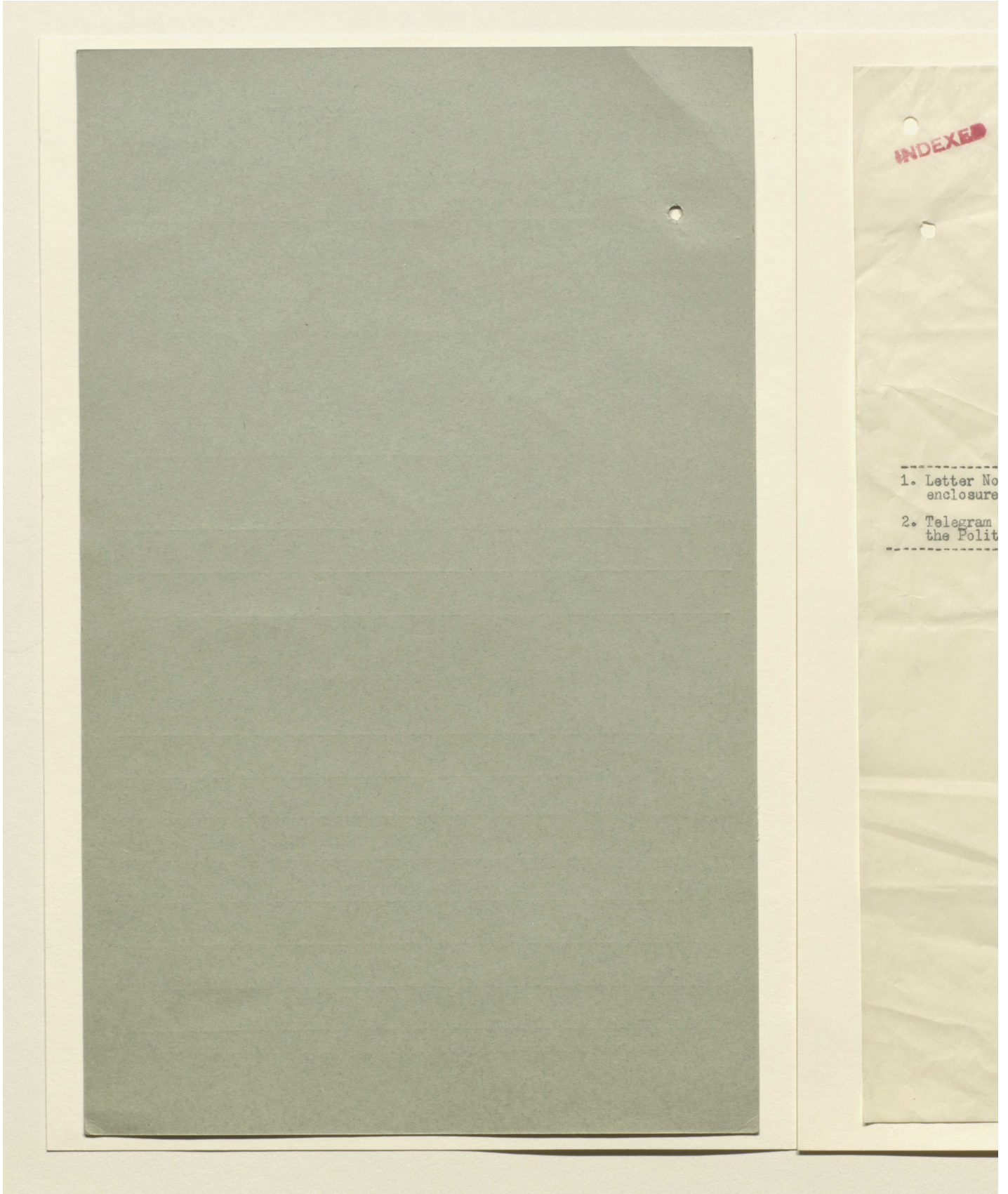

Order of deportation against Abdullah, British Indian subject, under the Muscat Order in Council.

In compliance with the instructions contained in Article 22(6) of the Muscat Order in Council, I forward, herewith, the marginally cited papers in

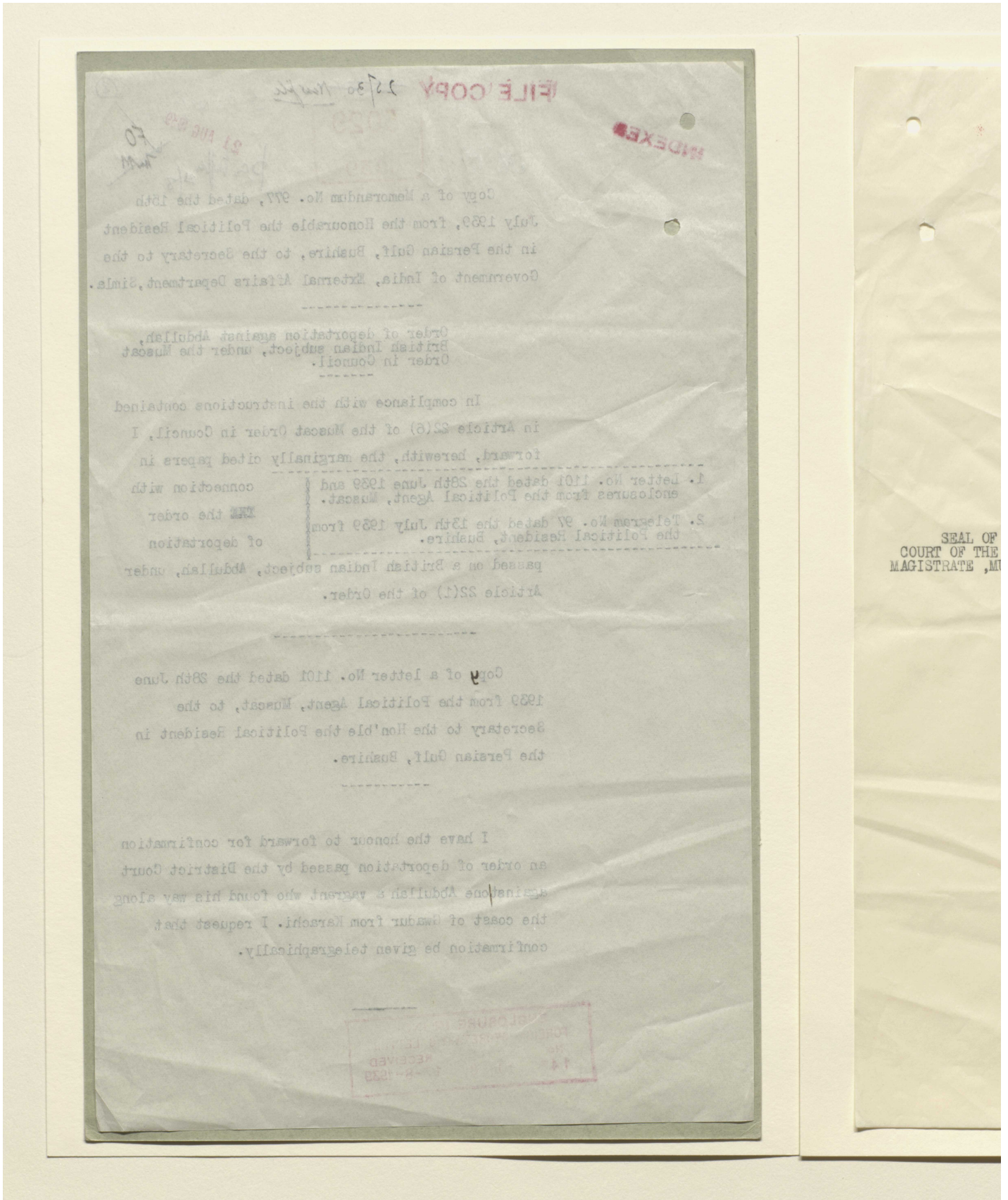
of deportation passed on a British Indian subject, Abdullah, under Article 22(1) of the Order.

Copy of a letter No. 1101 dated the 28th June 1939 from the Political Agent, Muscat, to the Secretary to the Hon'ble the Political Resident in the Persian Gulf, Bushire.

I have the honour to forward for confirmation an order of deportation passed by the District Court against one Abdullah a vagrant who found his way along the coast of Gwadur from Karachi. I request that confirmation be given telegraphically.

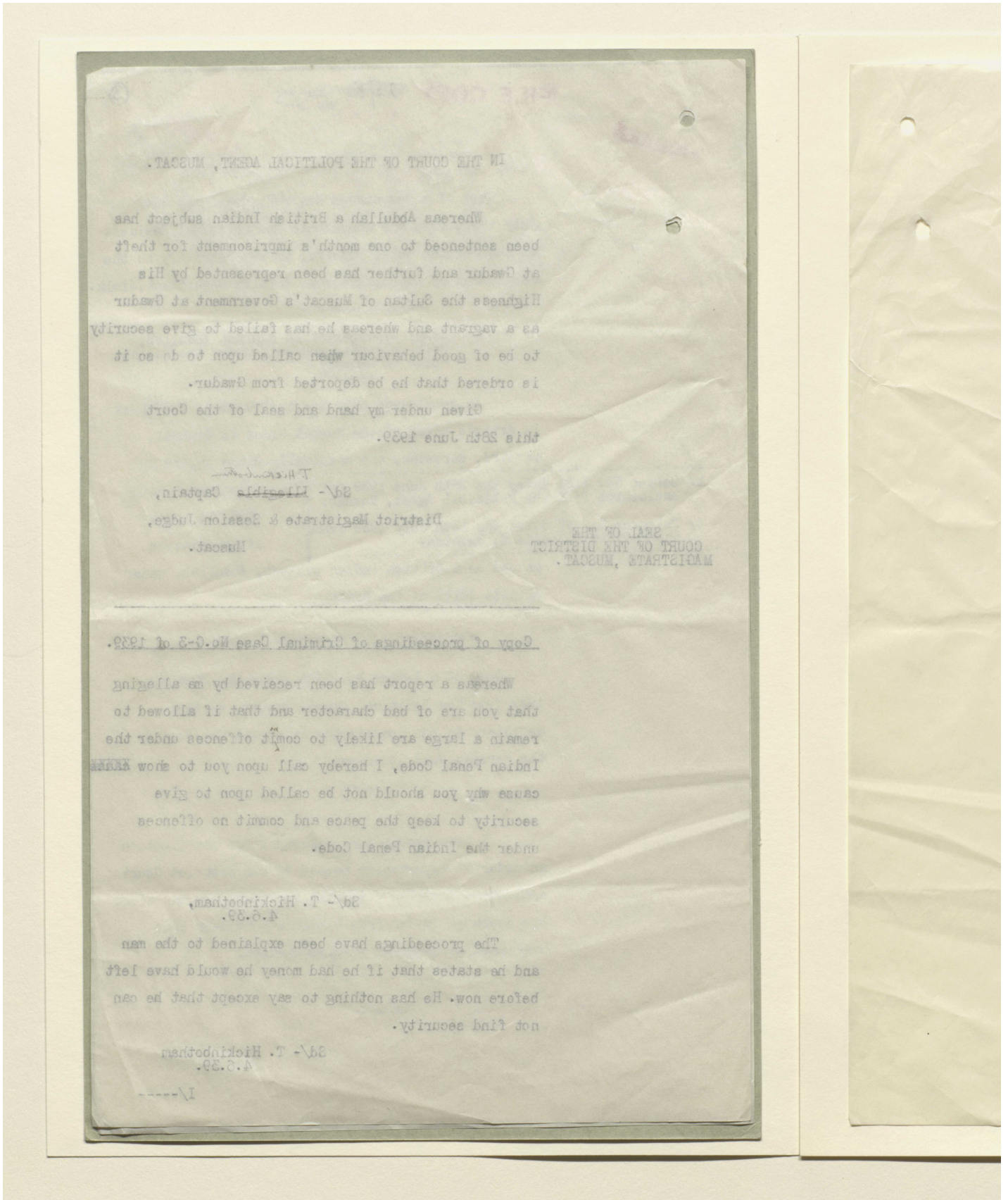

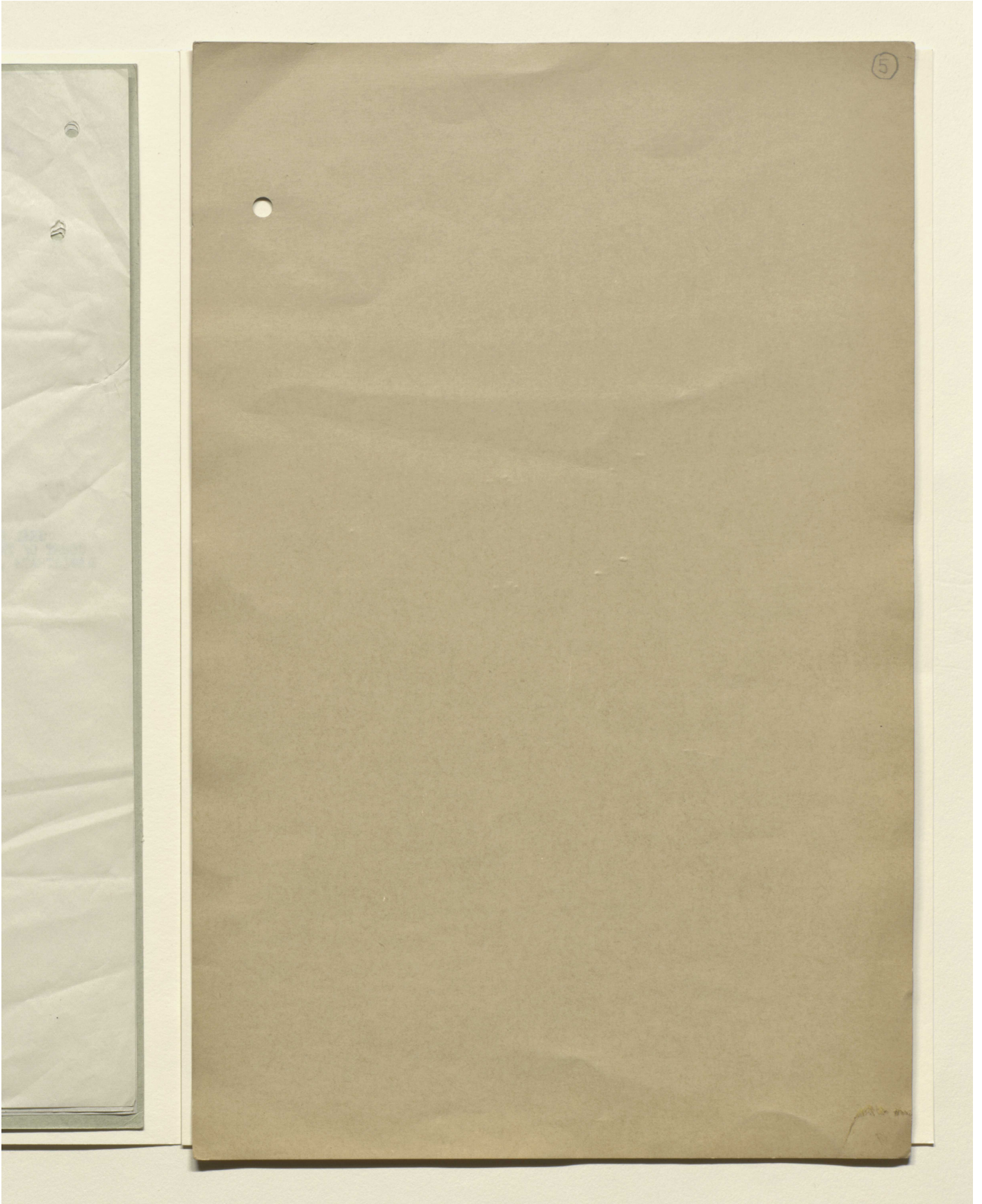
