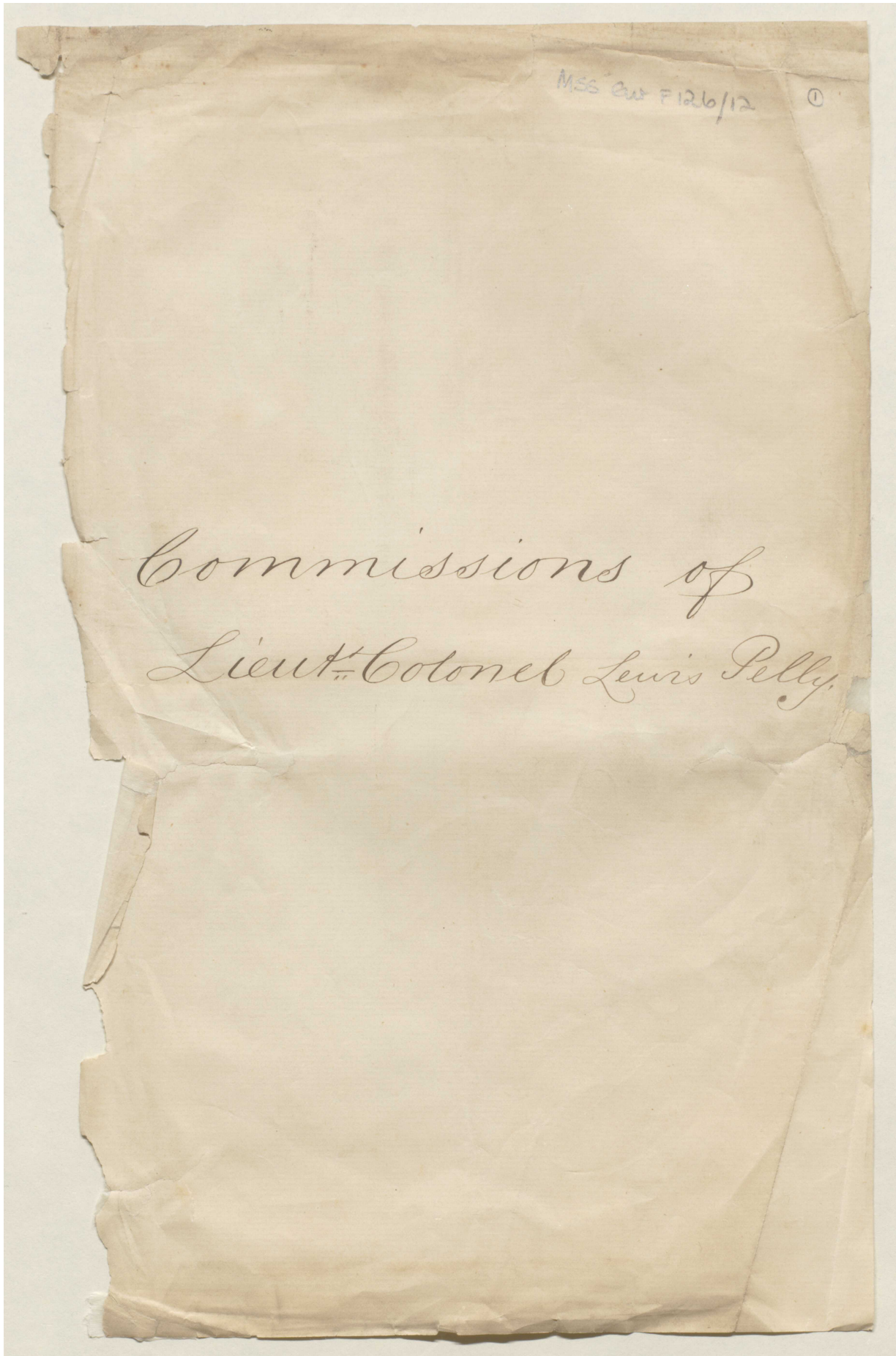

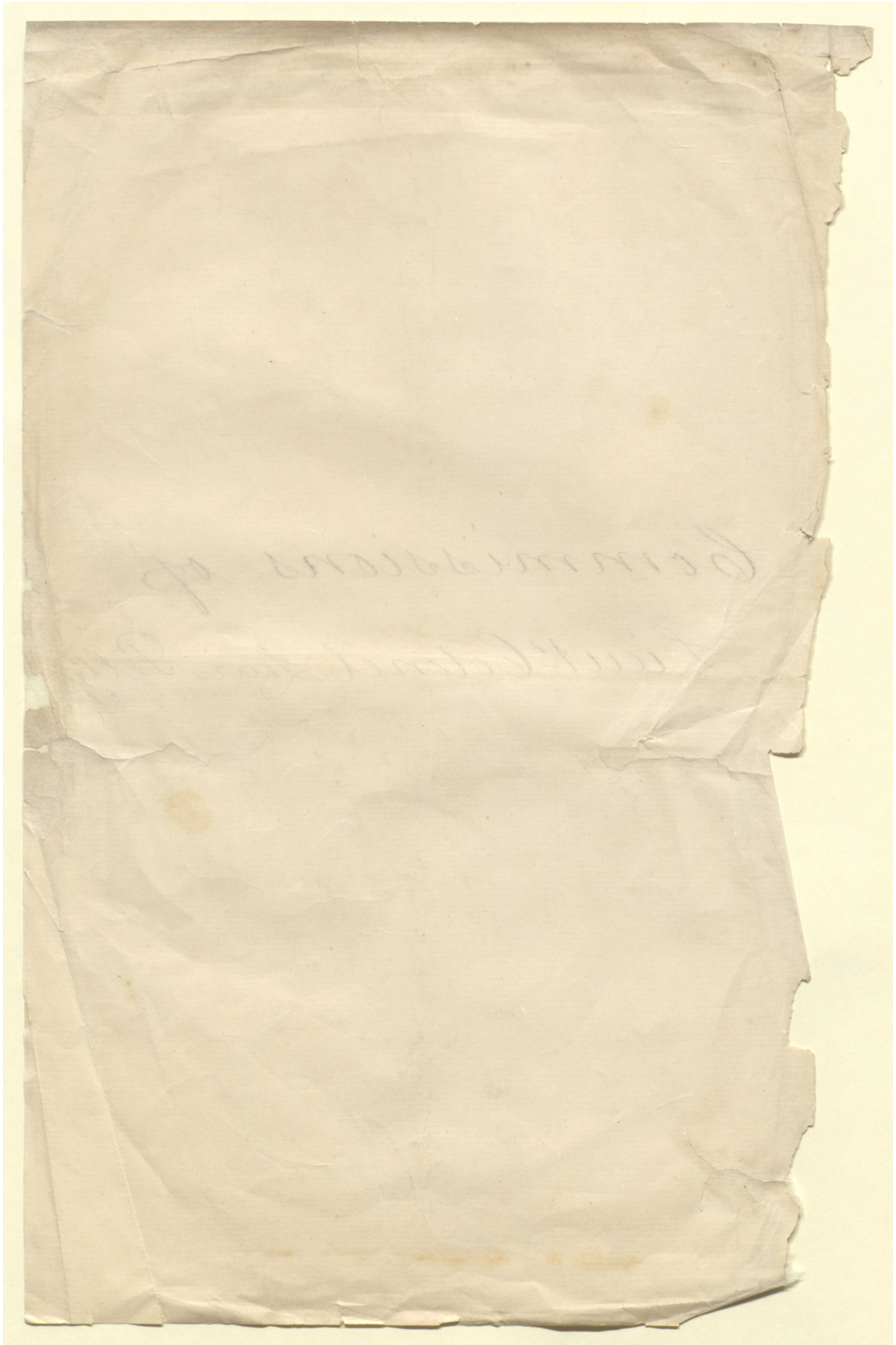


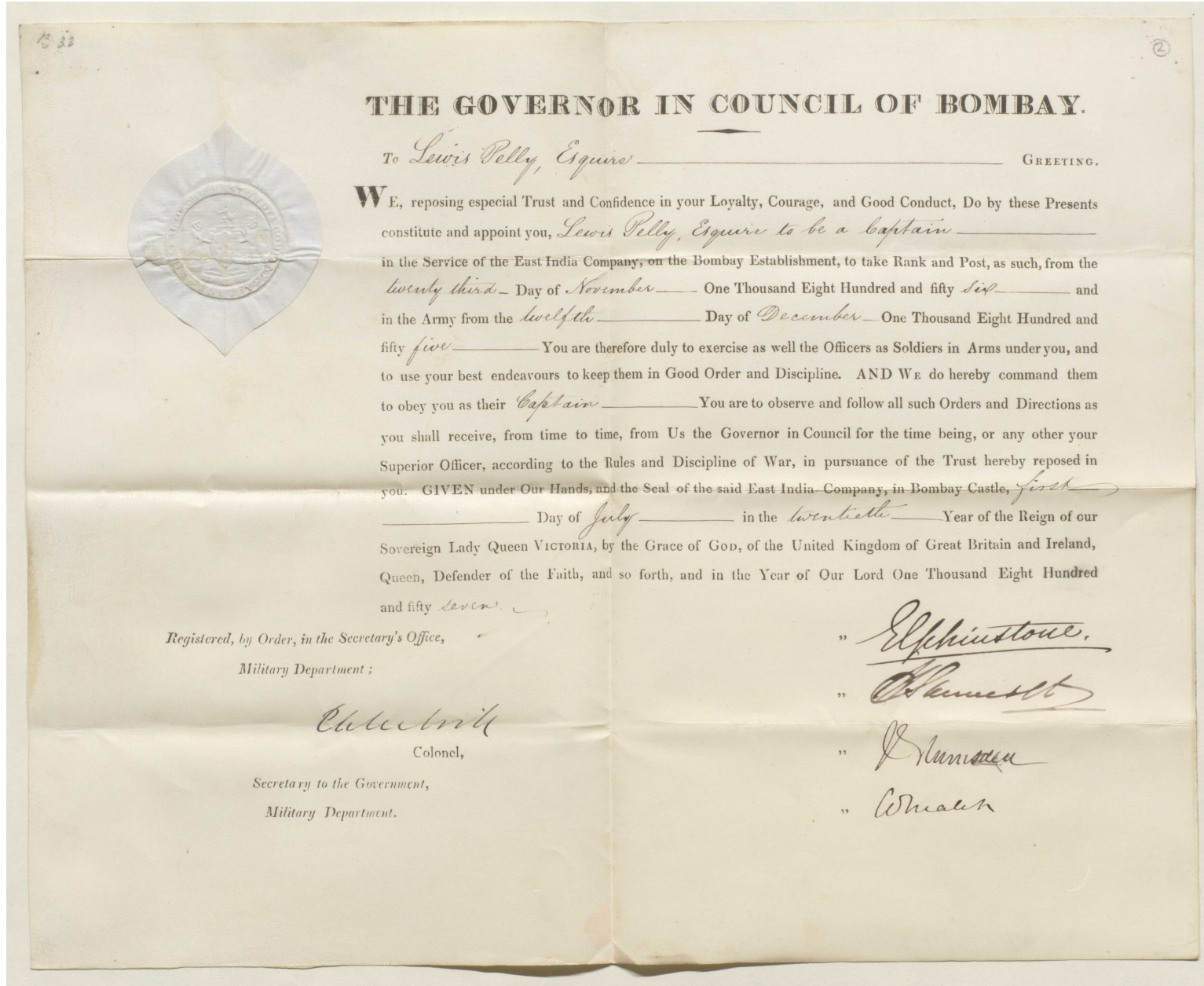
About this record

Certificates of commission for each of Lewis Pelly's appointments in the East India Company: Captain 23 November 1856; Major 18 February 1861; Lieutenant Colonel (Local Rank) 15 November 1861; Lieutenant Colonel (Local Rank) 30 June 1863; Lieutenant Colonel 12 December 1866; Major General 01 April 1882.

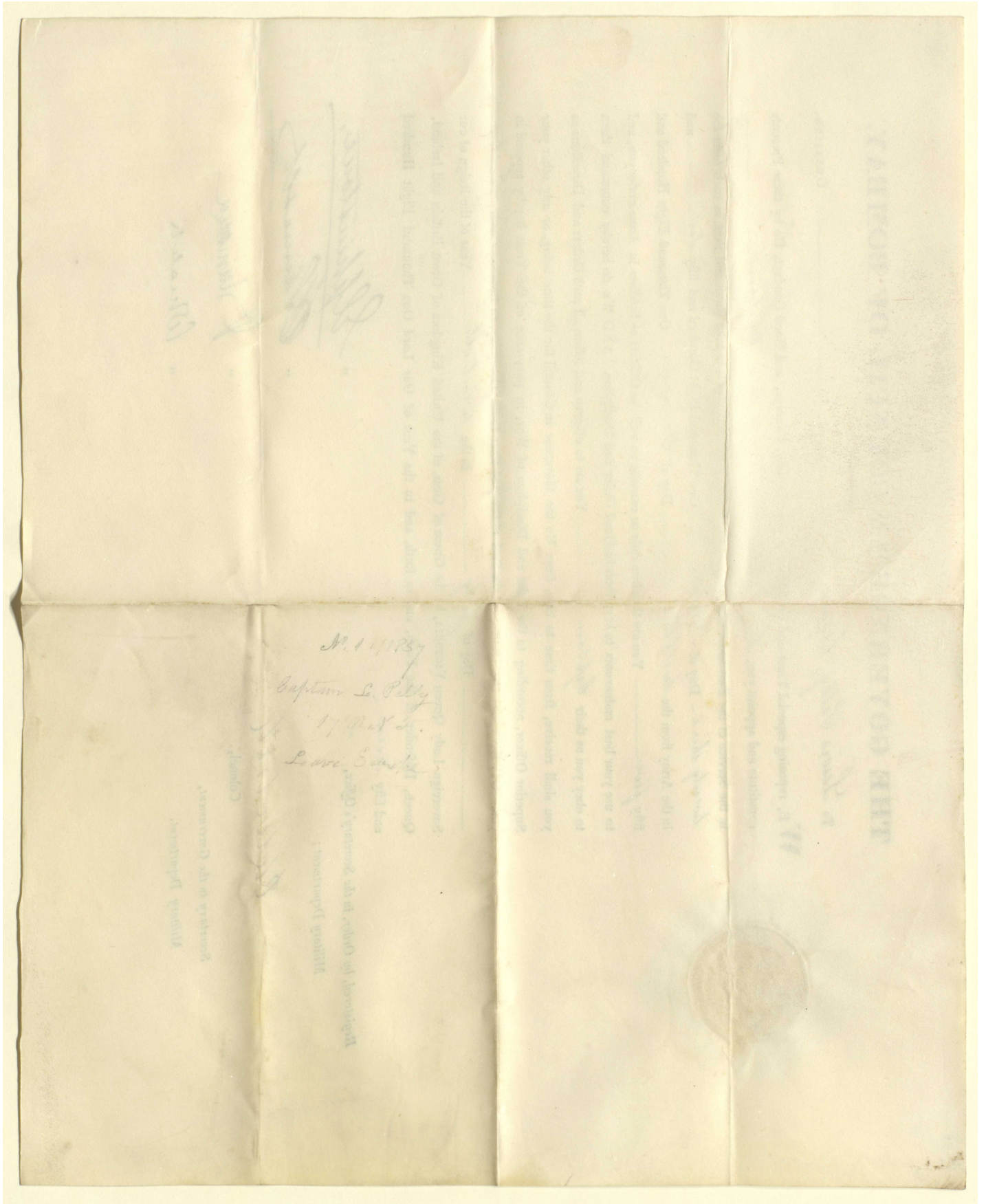
The commission certificate for the rank of Captain also records his appointment to this rank in the Bombay Army and dates that appointment as 12 December 1855.



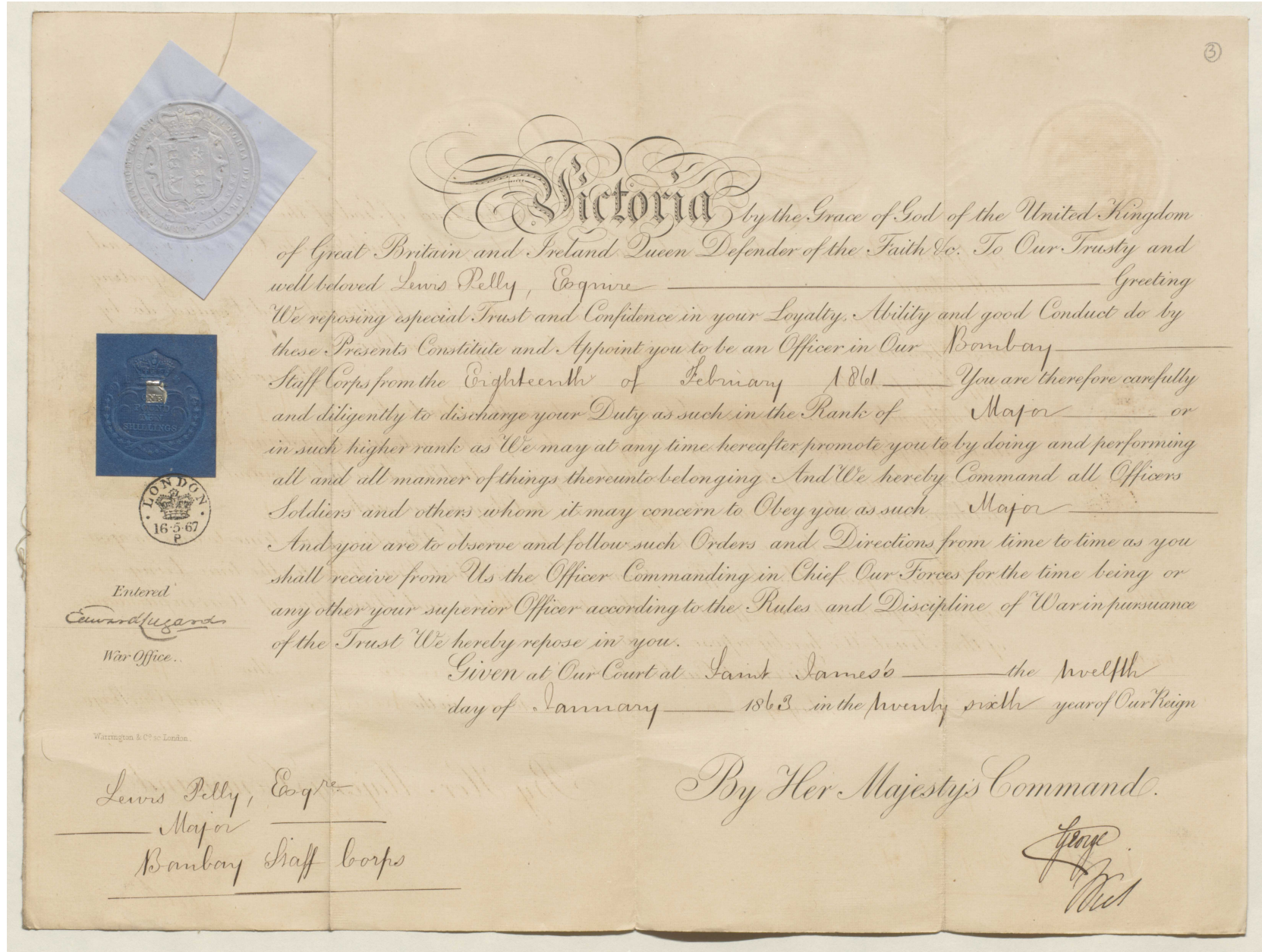




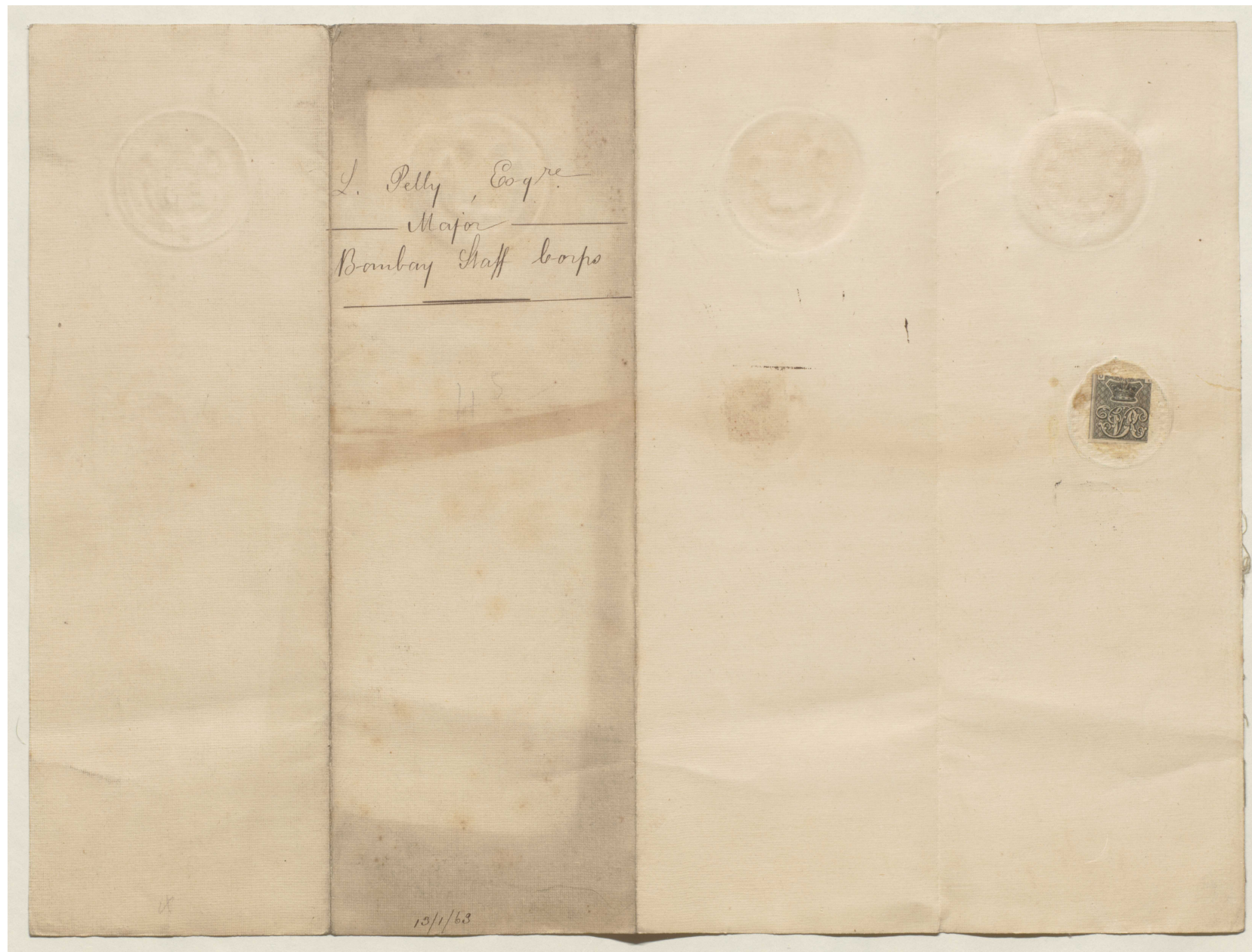
Commissions of Lieutenant Colonel Lewis Pelly [2v] (4/16)



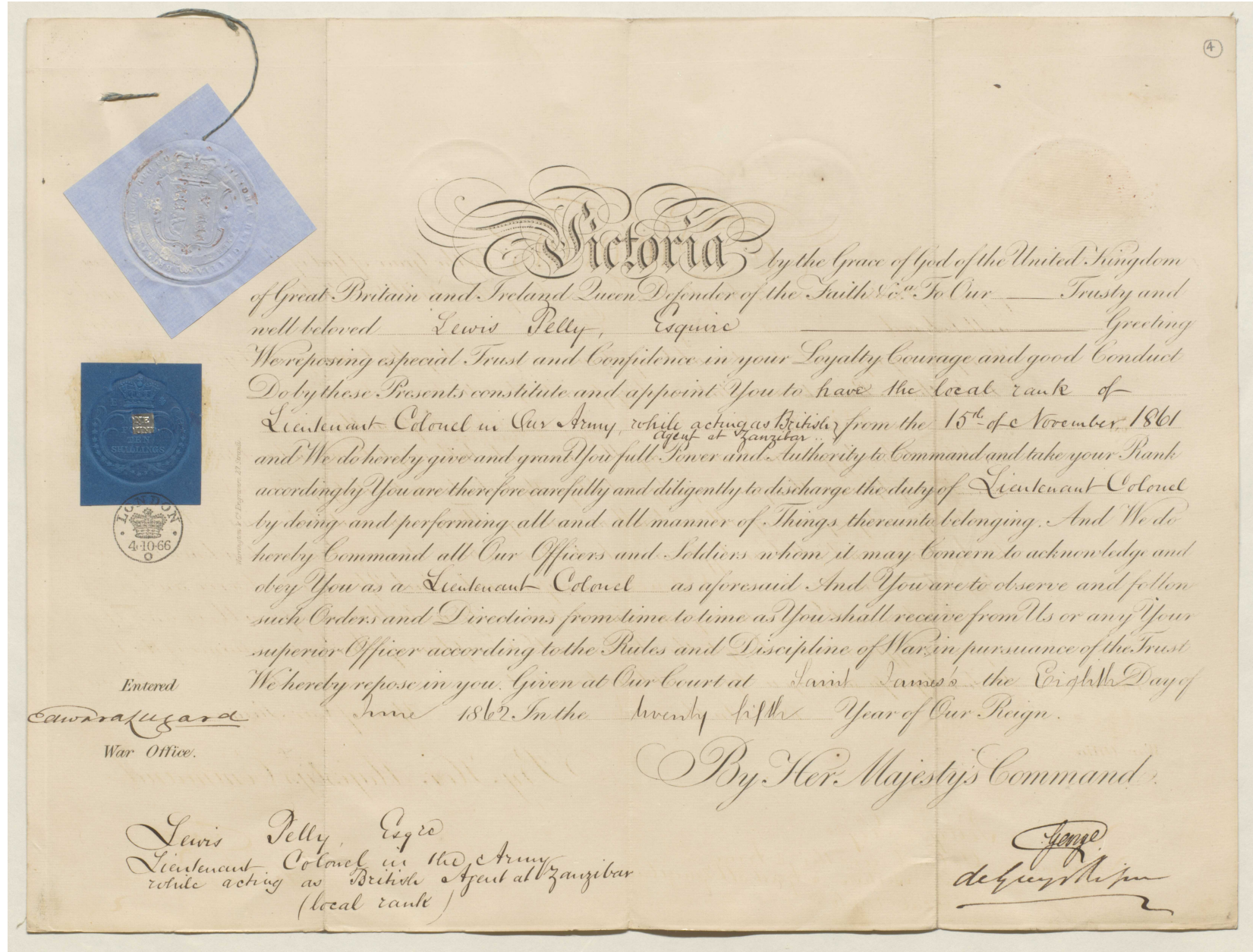
Commissions of Lieutenant Colonel Lewis Pelly [3r] (5/16)

We reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty Courage and good Conduct
Do by these Presents constitute and appoint You to have the local rank of Lieutenant Colonel in
Our Army whilst filling the appointment of Resident in the _____ from the 30th of June 1863
and We do hereby give and grant You full Power and Authority to Command and take your Rank
accordingly You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of Lieutenant Colonel
by doing and performing all and all manner of Things therunto belonging. And We do
hereby Command all Our Officers and Soldiers whom it may Concern to acknowledge and
obey You as a Lieutenant Colonel as aforesaid. And You are to observe and follow
such Orders and Directions from time to time as You shall receive from Us or any Your
superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War in pursuance of the Trust
We hereby repose in you. In witness whereof the ^{Principal Marshals} General Commanding in Chief, and one
of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the Order of Her Majesty
in Council, bearing date the Seventh day of June 1862, and by Command of Her Majesty
under Her Royal Sign Manual of even date herewith, herunto subscribe their names this
Twenty fourth day of _____ One thousand eight hundred and sixty three.

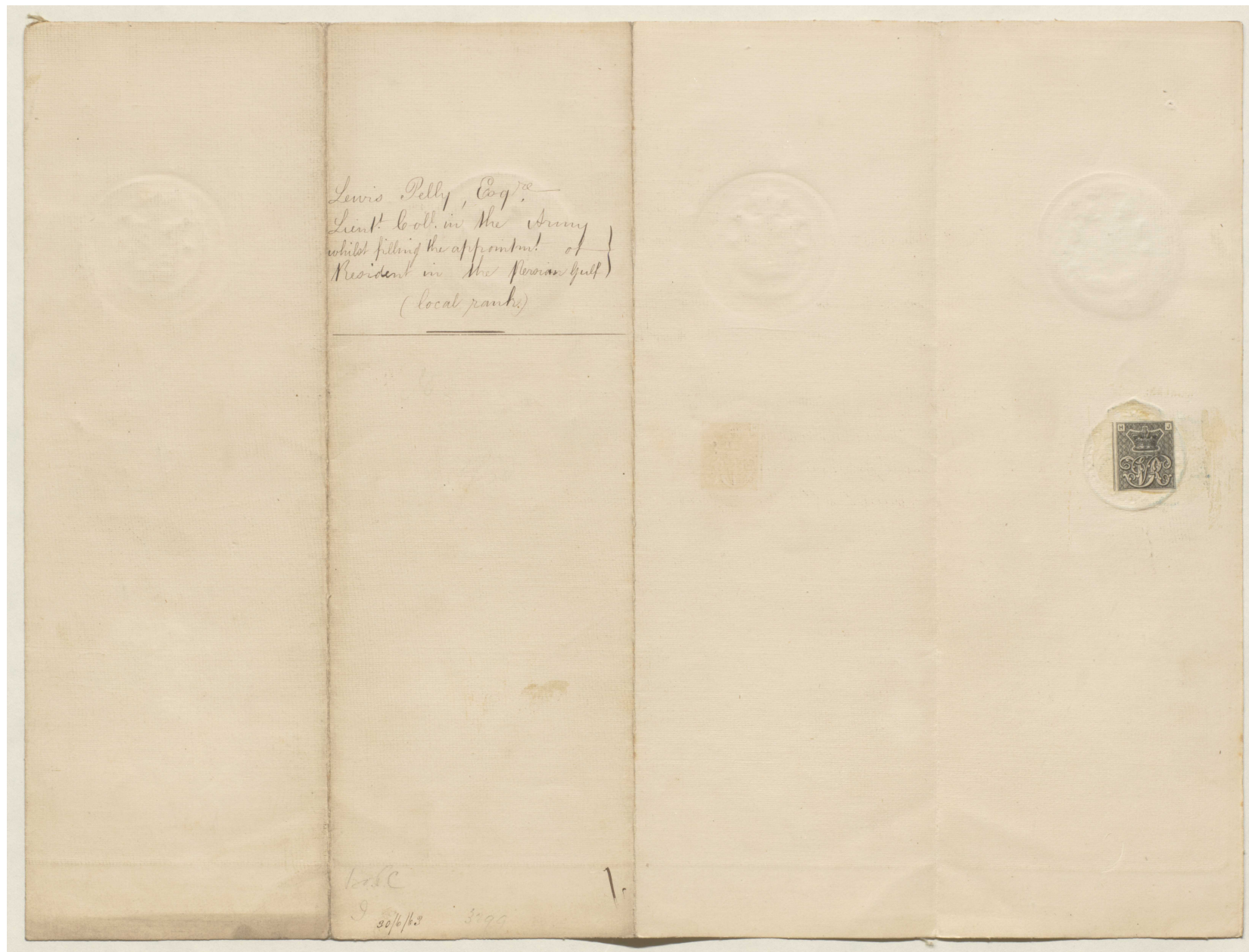

We reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty Ability and good Conduct do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be Lieutenant Colonel in Our Bombay Staff Corps from the Twelfth of December 1866 — You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of Lieutenant Colonel in Our said Corps by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging. And We hereby Command all Officers Soldiers and others whom it may concern to Obeey you as such Lieutenant Colonel. And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us the Officer Commanding in Chief Our Forces for the time being or any other your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War in pursuance of the Trust We hereby repose in you.

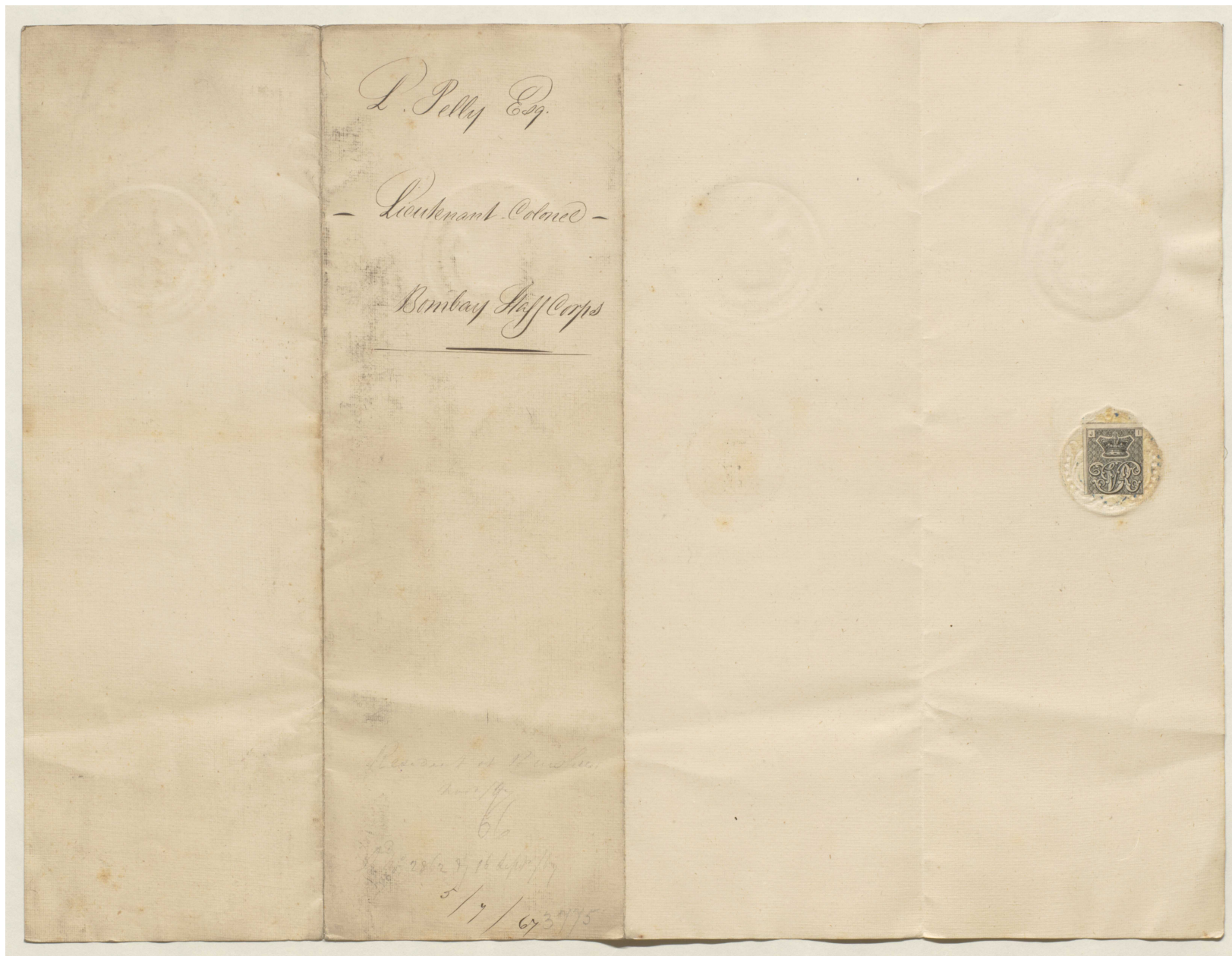

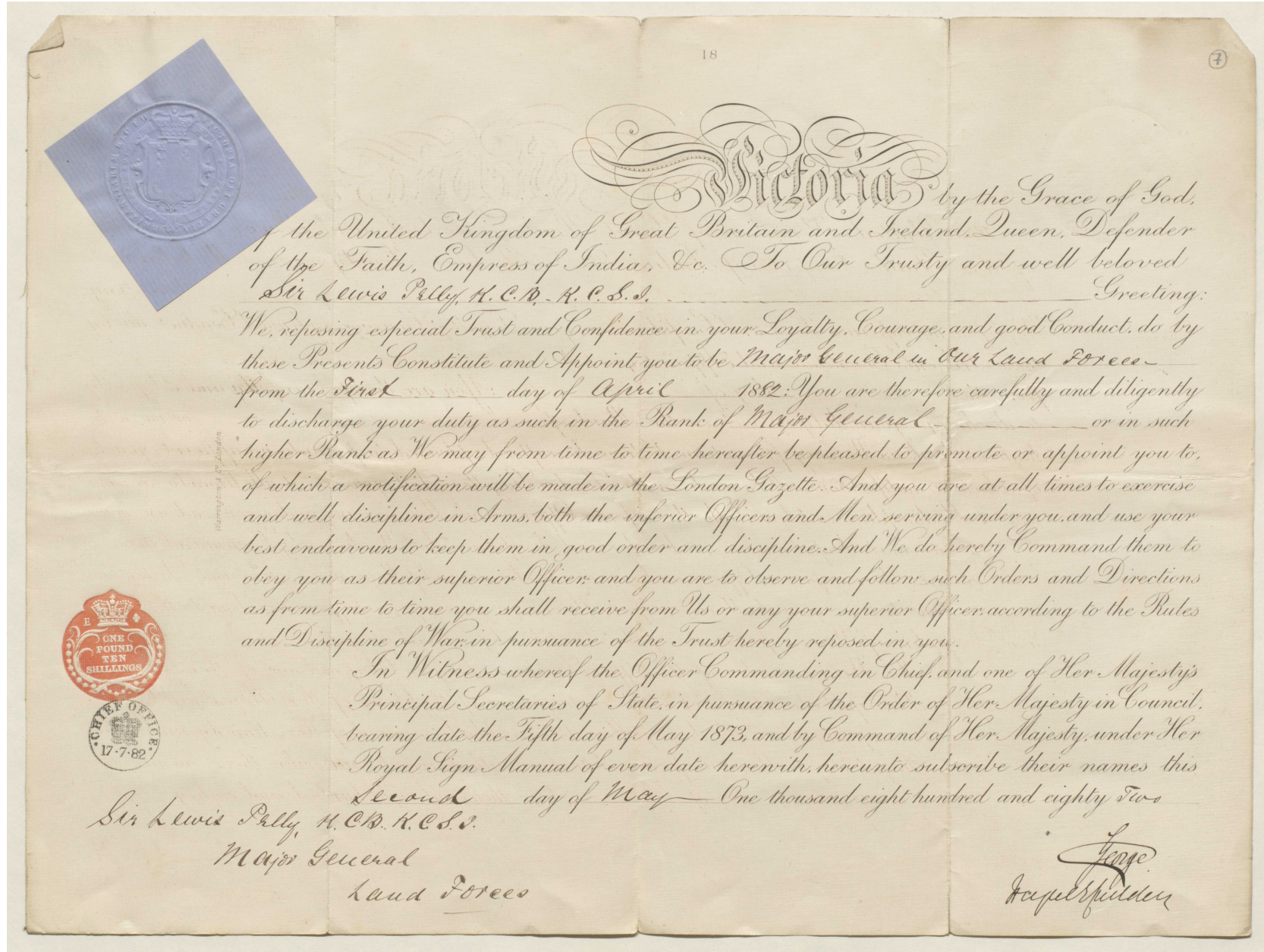
