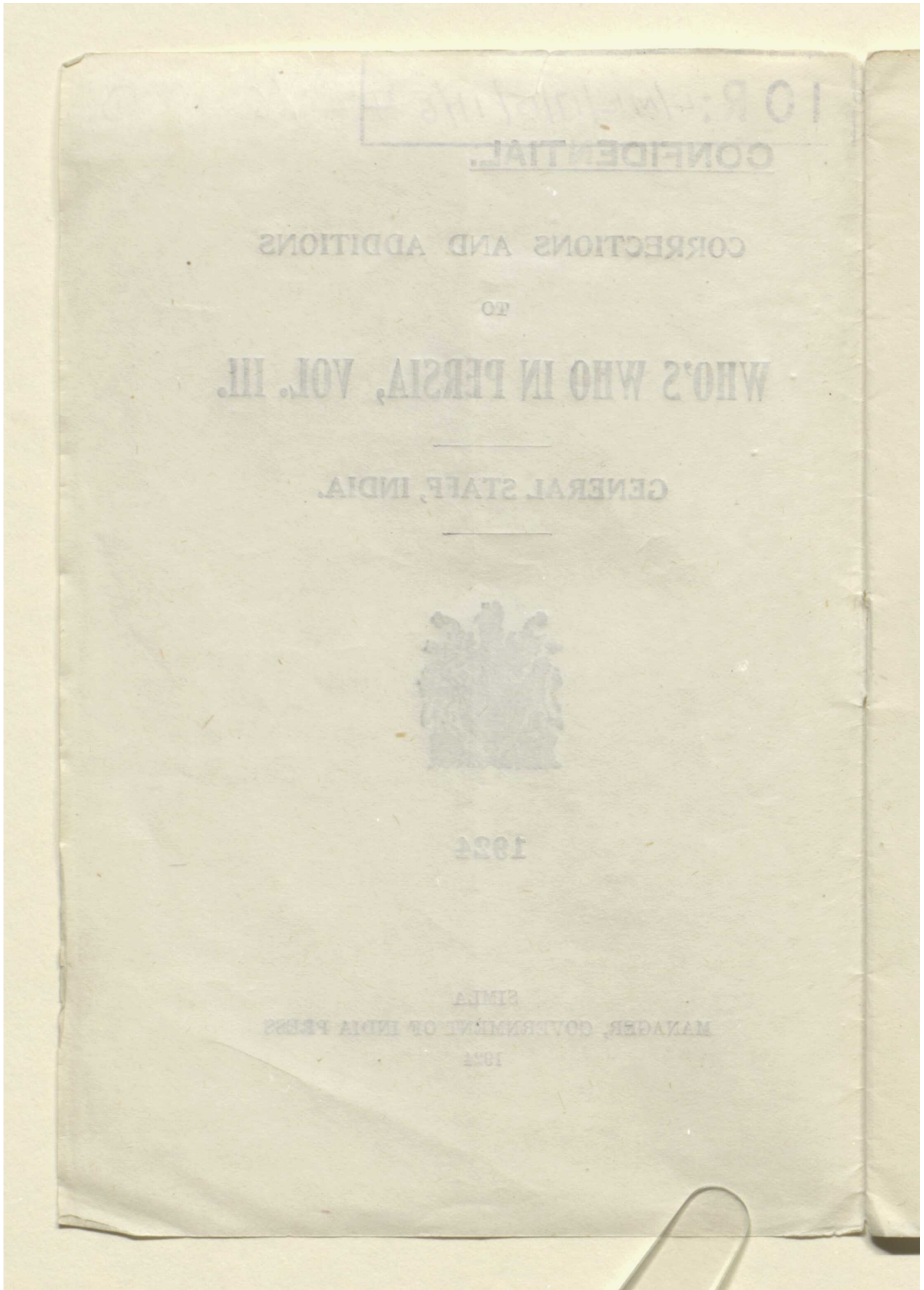

Page 7.—After entry for AZAD-UD-DOWLEH add:—

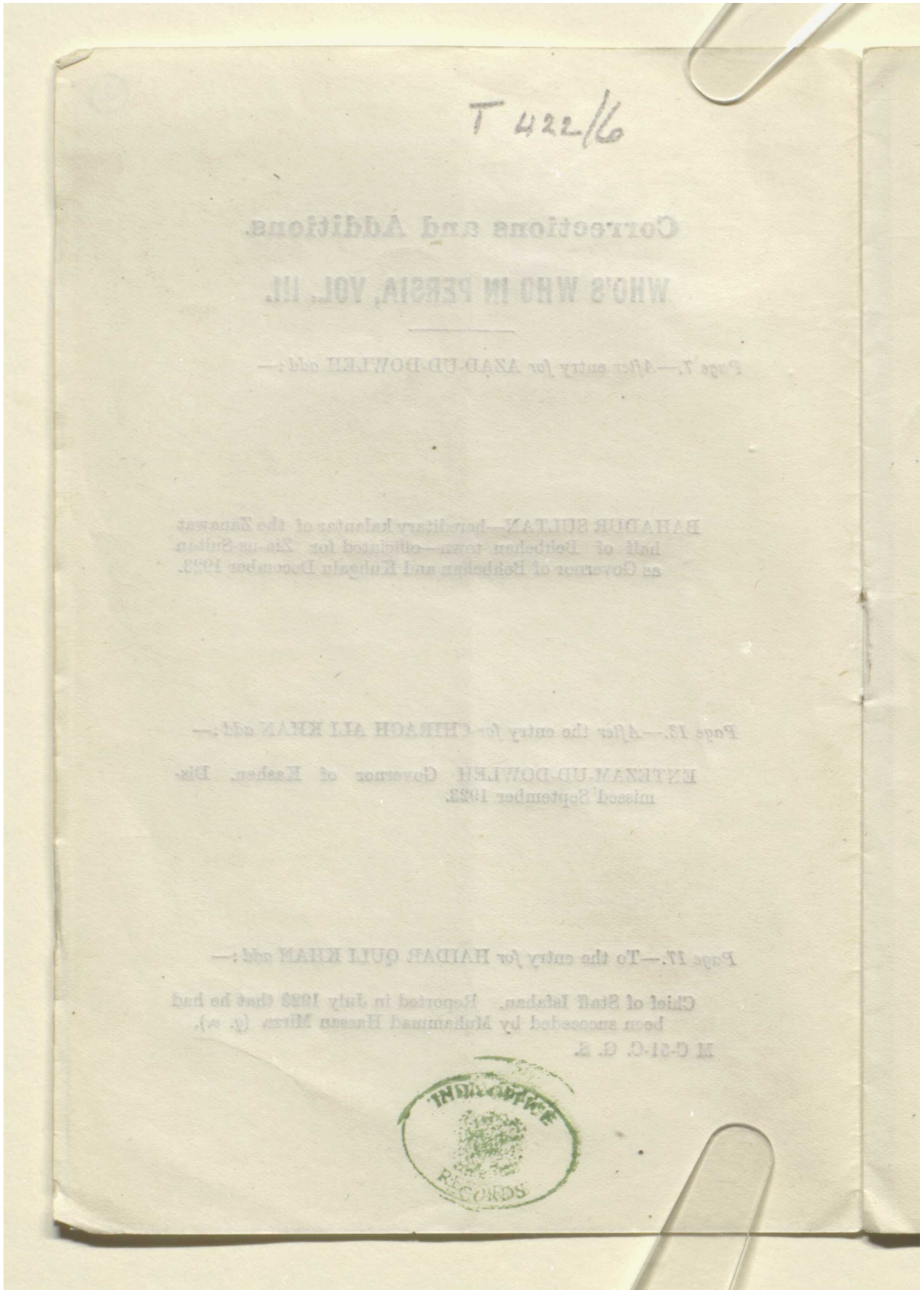
BAHADUR SULTAN—hereditary kalantar of the Zanawat
half of Behbahan town—officiated for Zia-us-Sultan
as Governor of Behbahan and Kuhgalu December 1923.

Page 13.—After the entry for CHIRAGH ALI KHAN add:—

ENTEZAM-UD-DOWLEH Governor of Kashan. Dis-
missed September 1923.

Page 17.—To the entry for HAIDAR QULI KHAN add:—

Chief of Staff Isfahan. Reported in July 1923 that he had
been succeeded by Muhammad Hassan Mirza (*q. v.*),
M C-51-C. G. S.

Page 17.—After the entry for HAZI ABDUR KARIM KHAN
add:—

HAJI KHAN, *Shirvani* started a new party of democrats in
Isfahan under name of "Independent Democrats."
Intends publishing a newspaper under name of "*Kanin*."
Is brother of editor of Tehran paper "*Milan*".

Page 18.—After the entry for HAJI MUHAMMAD ALI add:—

HASSAN ALI MIRZA son of the late Agha Najafi and
nephew of Nurulla.

Page 21.—After the entry for JAVAD KHAN (2) add:—

JELA-US-SALTANEH Chief of Municipality Isfahan
arrived 3rd August 1923.

Page 24.—After the entry for MIRZA ABDULLAH MUSTOUFI
add:—

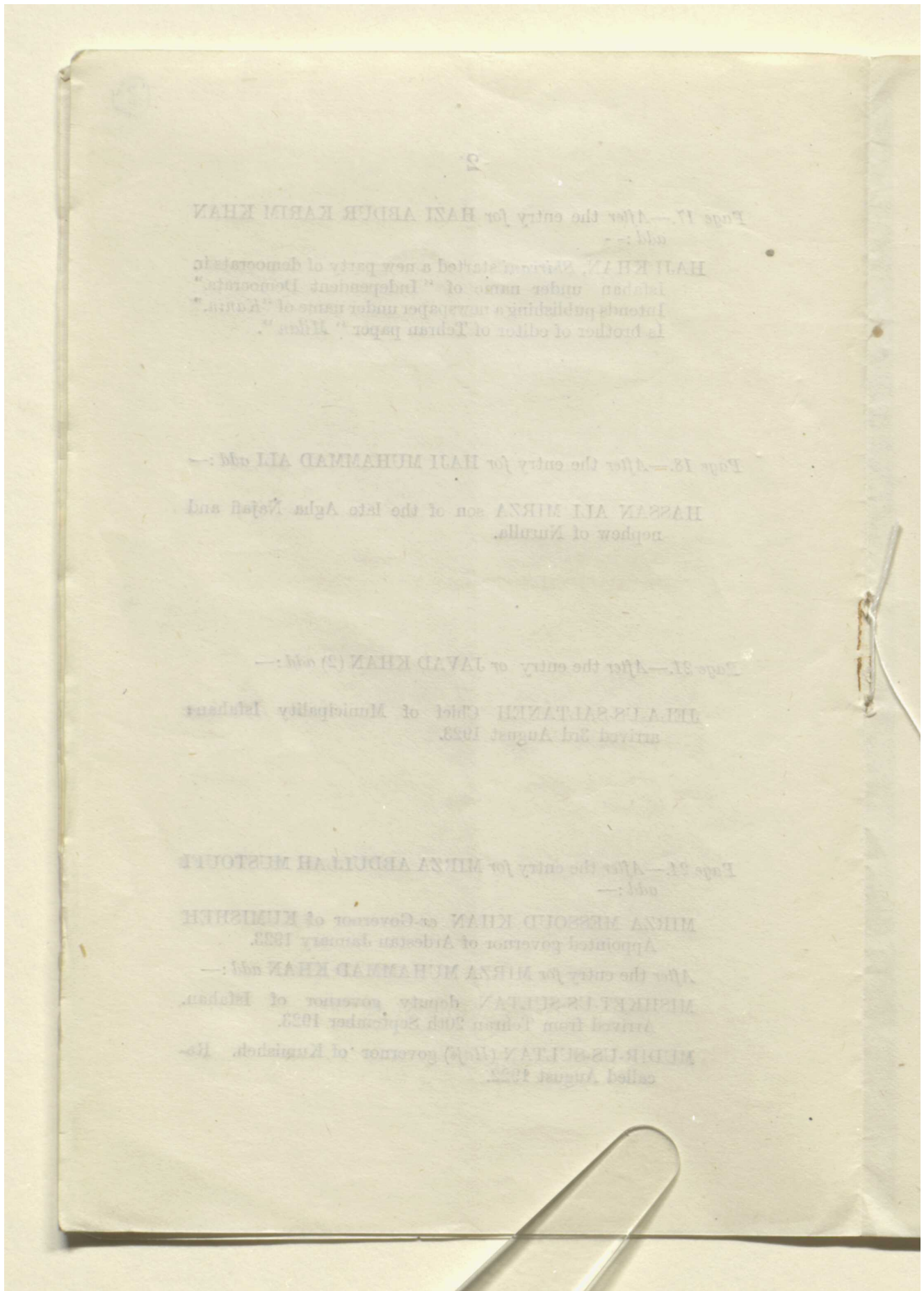
MIRZA MESSOUD KHAN *ex*-Governor of KUMISHEH
Appointed governor of Ardestan January 1923.

After the entry for MIRZA MUHAMMAD KHAN add:—

MISHKET-US-SULTAN deputy governor of Isfahan.
Arrived from Tehran 20th September 1923.

MUDIR-US-SULTAN (*Haji*) governor of Kumisheh. Re-
called August 1922.

Page 29.—After the entry for JAFAR SAIYID add :—

MUHAMMAD HASSAN MIRZA—son of Farman Farma—
reported in July 1923 that he had superseded Haidar
Quli Khan as Chief of Staff Isfahan.

Page 29.—After the entry for MULK ARA add :—

MUSAVI ZADEH—editor of "*Shiyam*". Expelled from
Tehran 1922 for defamatory publications re: Shah's
visit to Paris. Arrived Isfahan February 1923.

MUSHAR-UD-DOULEH resigned Governor-Generalship
of Arabistan October 1923. During his tenure of office
he earned respect of all classes by his honesty and tact.
Appointed Governor of Larek Khism and Henjam
February 1924: (see also Volume IV.)

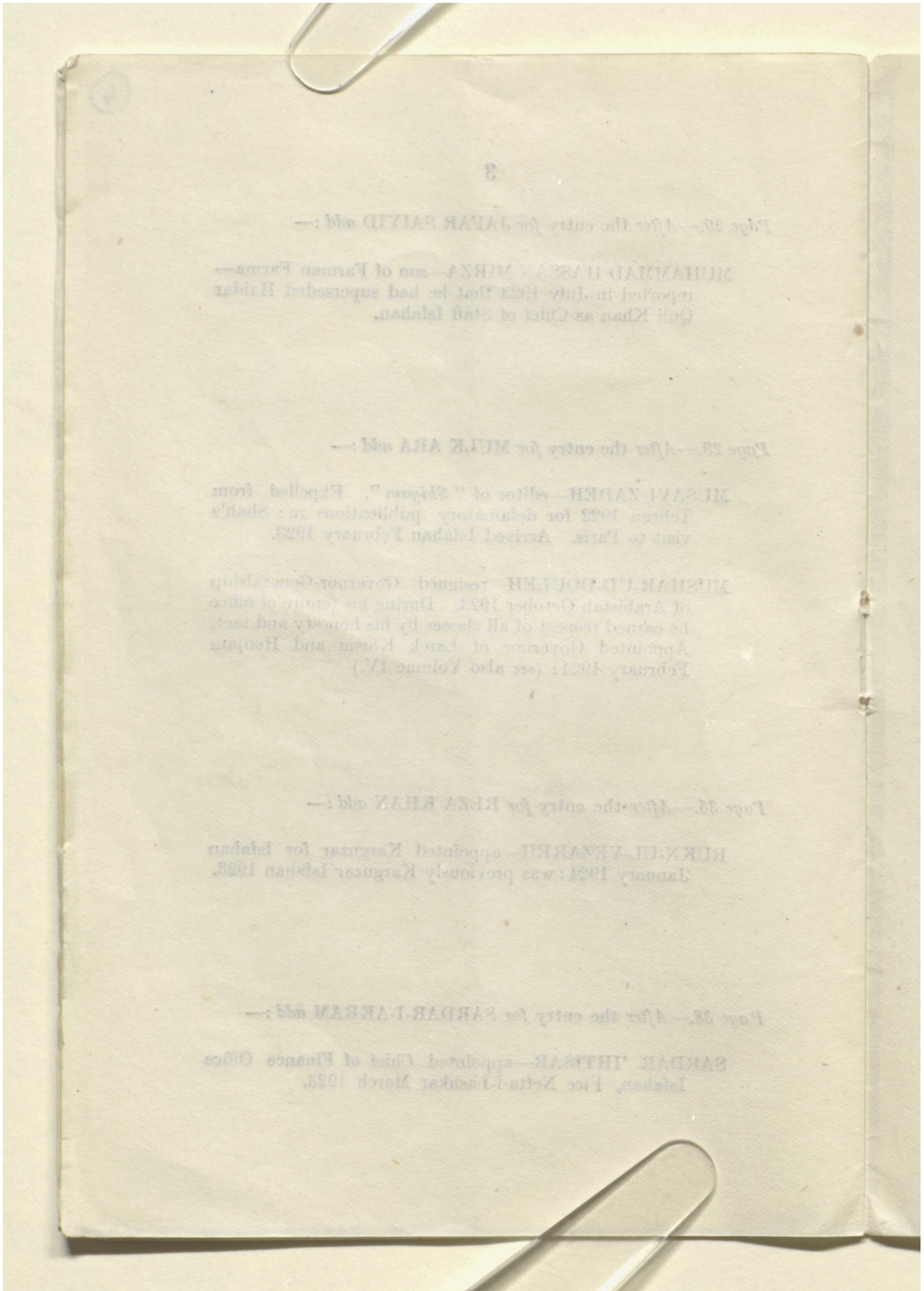
Page 35.—After the entry for REZA KHAN add :—

RUKN-UL-VEZAREH—appointed Karguzar for Isfahan
January 1924: was previously Karguzar Isfahan 1923.

Page 38.—After the entry for SARDAR-I-AKRAM add :—

SARDAR 'IHTISAR—appointed Chief of Finance Office
Isfahan, Vice Nefta-i-Lashkar March 1923.

ASSAD”.

Page 39.—After the entry for SARTIP KHAN add:—

SARUSH—Chief of Indirect Taxes Isfahan. Transferred
to Yezd July 1923.

Page 42.—After the entry for SULTAN ALI KHAN add:—

SULTAN ASADULLAH KHAN (*Salmasi*)—Formerly
served in 2nd Cavalry S. P. R. Transferred from Gover-
norship of Kazerun to Acting Civil Governorship of
Behbahan and Kuhgalu December 1923.

Page 48.—After the entry for SULTAN MUHAMMAD KHAN
add:—

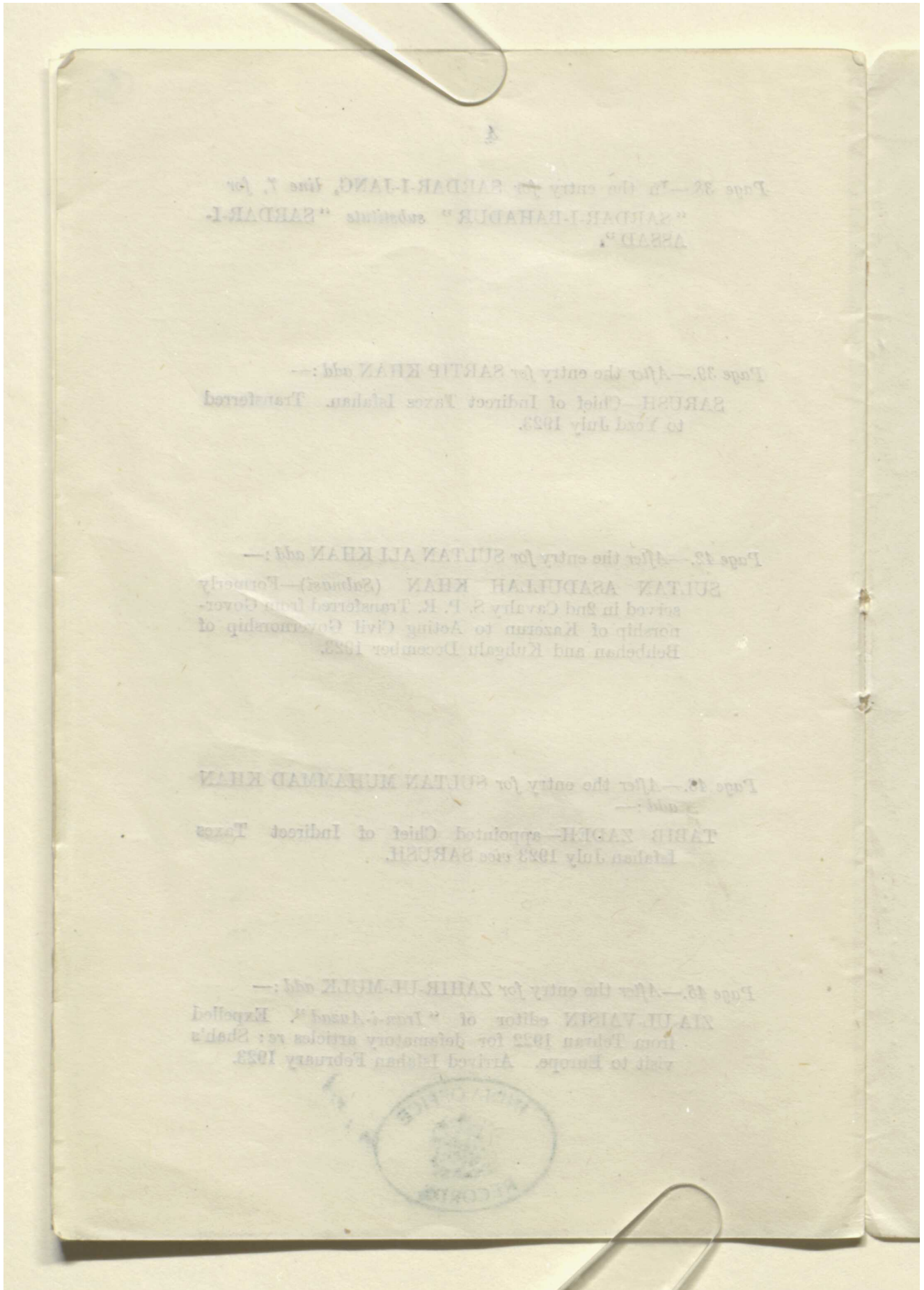
TABIB ZADEH—appointed Chief of Indirect Taxes
Isfahan July 1923 *vice* SARUSH.

Page 45.—After the entry for ZAHIR-UL-MULK add:—

ZIA-UL-VAISIN editor of “*Iran-i-Auzad*”. Expelled
from Tehran 1922 for defamatory articles *re*: Shah's
visit to Europe. Arrived Isfahan February 1923.
